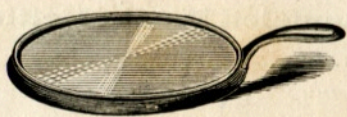

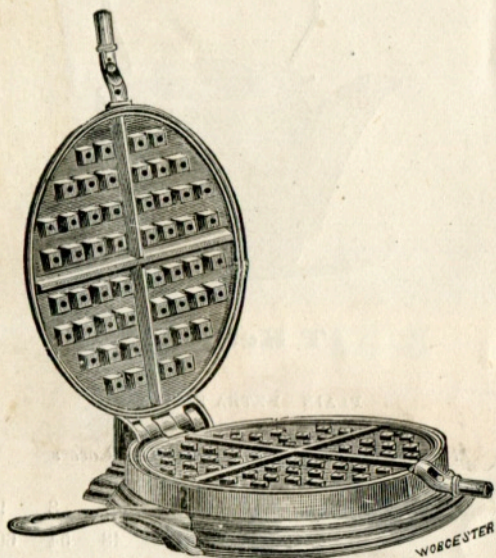


Galvanized Tea Kettle.

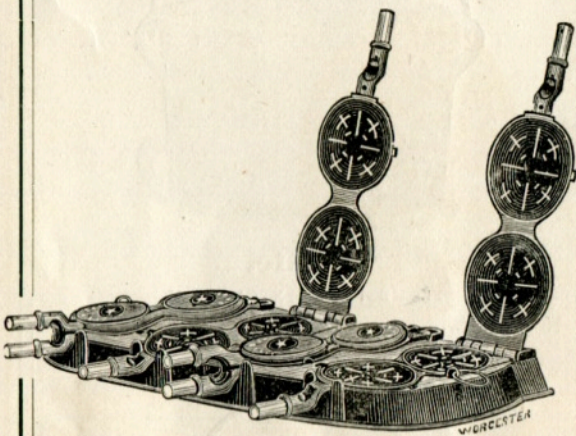

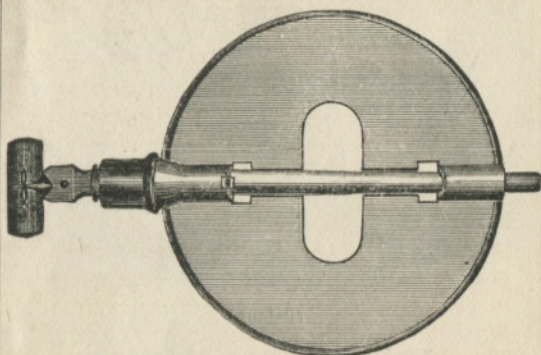

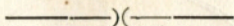
